About the Day We Call Sunday

Always pray before opening your Bible. Find the text in your Bible and write the answer.

Millions of sincere Christians conscientiously go to church and refrain from ordinary activities on the first day of the week, which is called Sunday. They believe that they are doing what God has asked them to do.

If one were to ask a dozen different Christians why they worship on the first day of the week instead of the seventh as God has commanded, he would probably receive five or six different explanations. There is no uniformity in the reasons given for altering God's day of worship. Some will say that the day was changed at Pentecost, others will say that Christ, at His death instituted another day. Still others admit that they do not know why the change was made.

There is only one safe guide to follow the Bible. Let us not depend upon tradition; let us build on Bible as we study.
