
Florida Awards

CAGED PETS

- 1. Care for a caged pet for at least three months.
- 2. What kinds of food does your pet eat?
- 3. Where does your pet sleep?
- 4. What is your pet's name.
- 5. Share your pet at a club meeting and tell a story about your pet and why it is special to you.
- 6. Draw a picture of your pet and write it's name.
- 7. Who created your pet? What day was it created on?



HELPS:

1. A caged pet could be a hamster, mouse, guinea pig, bird, lizard, rabbit, turtle, etc.

2. As a group, learn what foods different pets eat. 3. Have the children draw a picture of their pet's bed. 4. Discuss how God knows your name and your pet, also. Read and talk about God's care for you (Psalm 139, Luke 12:7, Matthew 10:30) 5. Give each child a chance to talk about their pet. Some children may need to be timed. You may wish to have four or five children each evening until all have had a turn. 6. Help the children spell their pet's name and encourage them to draw their pet sitting, running, etc. 7.
