 - a. Death
 - b. Sorrow in childbirth
 - c. Cursed ground, thorns & thistles
 - d. Both the serpent & animals where cursed & changed.
 - e. Clothing was now needed because the glory of God no longer covered them.

- 6. Genesis 3:21 God! An animal was killed to make clothing. This was the first death resulting from sin. (Adam & Eve now needed clothing)
 - Genesis 4 Cain's murder of Abel could also be used.
