


FINGER PAINTING

- 1. What are finger paints mixed with?
- 2. How can you make finger paints. If you cannot buy them ready made?
- 3. What kind of paper do you use and why?
- 4. What are the "primary" colors? Make sample.
- 5. What do you get by mixing blue and yellow? Make sample.
- 6. What do you get by mixing blue and red? Make sample.
- 7. What do you get by mixing red and yellow? Make sample.
- 8. Paint with one color 3 different "strokes" (vertical, horizontal, curves).
- 9. Paint with two colors a nature object (flower, butterfly, tree, etc.).
- 10. Paint a picture of your own choice.



HELPS:

- 2. Mix wallpaper paste and water to a creamy smooth consistency and add dry or moist poster paints.
- 3. Use glossy, smooth paper (glazed finger painting paper is available in craft shops). "Smooth" craft or wrapping paper can be used for try outs. Wet surface with a sponge before painting so paints will "glide" on easier. Porous paper will absorb paints (not good).
- 4. Red, Yellow, Blue
- 5. Green
- 6. Purple
- 7. Orange
