- 4. Listen to at least one story, or watch a tape or slide show about missionaries, or a mission project and be able to ex plain what a missionary does and why he/she is needed.
- 5. Name some ways you can be a missionary or how you can help missionary work around the world to spread the *"Good News."*
- 6. Save up money that you would usually spend on yourself for at least 1 month, then decide what mission project you

will do nate this money to so other children in the world will know the love of Jesus.

- 7. Donate one nearly new toy and one article of clothing to a missionary project.
- 8. Participate in at least 2 of the following missionary projects:
 - Tell a mission story to your club or Sabbath School class.
 - Send at least 2 letters or cards to a missionary or their children encouraging them in their work.
 - Make a prayer log, and pray for a missionary project at 4 times a week for 3 or more months.

- Read at least 2 books about missionaries and wht they do.


- Help in a project or program that will teach your church
