PIN/BUTTON

- 1. Collect at least (15) pin type buttons.
- 2. In this collection have at least four (4) different round sizes.
- Collect at least four (4) different shapes.
- 4. Include six (6) religious buttons in your collection
- 5. Have a trading time and trade at least three (3) buttons with other Adventurers
- 6. Learn to play fair and share if you have extra
- 7. Mount your pin/button collection neatly on a cloth back ground.
- 8. Display your collection at a club meeting or youth fair.
- 9. When were pin/buttons first used?
- 10. Share with the club how and when you obtained your first pin/button and where it came from.



HELPS:

The aim is to enjoy and neatly display your collection, and to learn to share with others and to fairly trade pin/buttons. Variety is more important than large numbers.

Collect different shapes, colors, and sizes of buttons.

These button pins are to be inexpensive campaign-type buttons pins, not the more costly stud-type button/pins as made for AJY pins.

You may wish to borrow a "button machine" and make an individual button for each child to add to their collection one of their own creation or a picture of each child with name and date.
