## **HELPS:**

- 1. Let the children have their choice in either drawing or describing what a turtle looks like.
- 2. There are many different types of turtles in the United States. Approximately 44 species in the U.S. and 22 species in the state of Florida.
- 4. Plants and small animals.
- 5. Every 3 to 4 years.
- 6. They usually lay their eggs in a hole dug in the sand or in a rotting log. They usually cover their eggs after they have been laid.

They hatch close to eight days after they have been laid.

- 7. They can live up to 152 years.
- 8. The biggest threats are humans and fish nets.
- 9. The turtles webbed feet aid the turtle in swimming.
