

## **HELPS:**

- 1. Blue whale
- 2. Toothed whales and Baleen (or whalebone) whales.
- 3. Baleen--swim with mouth open, take in water and fish and plankton, close mouth, drain water out. Plankton, fish, trapped in baleen. Tongue scoops up food and swallows it. Toothed whales use teeth for catching food, then swallow food whole.
- 4. Mammals are animals that have lungs and breathe air (just like you and me). When we go swimming we have to come up to the surface for a gulp of air. Whales do, too. Whale babies drink milk from mother and have hair at least during one stage of life.
